I've been bass fishing for about 4 years, but have been fishing all my life. My grandparents own a lake house on Cedar Creek Lake and I've been going down there ever since I can remember. My favorite lake is Cedar Creek. My favorite technique is pitching/skipping docks or brush with shaky head rigged trick worms, senko's, and jigs. I also like throwing rattle traps, and D22's on windblown points. My Biggest bass is a 10 lb bass caught on a rattle trap on O.H Ivie 2 weeks before our Arlington Bass Club tournament. And about 2 hours after catching that 10LB bass my brother Caleb hooked me in the ear with the same rattle trap I caught the fish on. We just cut the hooks off the trap and went back to the ramp weighed the fish then with me griping the bathroom sink pried the 2 barbs out of my ear. When I'm not fishing with my Dad or Granddad I fish with my brothers Caleb 13 and Luke 11.
