Legal fishing hours are 5:00 AM – 2:00 PM both Saturday and Sunday. There is a 14" minimum for all fish brought to weigh-in

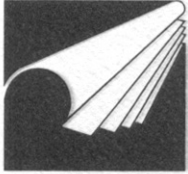
Lake Waco has Spotted Bass. Per TWPD web site there is no size minimum for spotted bass.

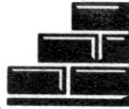

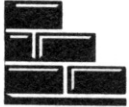
